SOP for conduction admission on the basis of Class XII Marks

1. Points to be considered while allocating the seats:

- (a) The Colleges must complete the undergraduate admissions process by Saturday, August 29, 2026.
- (b) The Admission Branch (University of Delhi) will be simultaneously allocating the seats to the Colleges under reference through the centralised CSAS based on CUET scores. The Colleges must accept these.
- (c) At the time of granting the admission, Colleges must check the minimum eligibility, Programme Specific Eligibility, Category documents and other aspects as stated in Bulletin of Information (UG) and Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS) (UG) 2026.
- (d) The Colleges must ensure that the candidates admitted by them are not admitted to any other College of the University of Delhi
- (e) The admissions must be done purely based on merit of the Class XII scores, on the vacant seats only
- (f) Colleges must ensure that no extra allocations, over and above the sanctioned seats of a programme, are done.
- (g) No admission shall be granted based on an undertaking for extension of time for submitting the documents related to the category of a candidate.
- (h) No admission shall be done on supernumerary seats, except PwBD.

2. Mechanism for Preparation of Merit Lists for All Programmes

- (a) The College shall invite online applications through a dedicated Merit-Based Admission Portal/ within the notified timeline.
- (b) The College Admission Committee shall verify the eligibility of each applicant in accordance with the University of Delhi Undergraduate Admission Guidelines.
- (c) Separate programme-wise and category-wise merit lists shall be prepared strictly on the basis of Class XII scores, programme-specific eligibility criteria, reservation policy and availability of seats.
- (d) The merit lists shall be approved by the College Admission Committee and advertised & published on the College website.
- (e) Before commencing the merit-based admission round, the College shall prepare and verify the exact vacancy position after taking into account:
 - (i) admissions already confirmed;
 - (ii) withdrawals and cancellations;
 - (iii) vacant seats in each programme and category;
 - (iv) applicable reservation requirements; and
 - (v) the sanctioned intake of the respective programmes

3. Mechanism for Collection of Fees and Remittance to the University

- (a) Candidates selected for admission shall receive an admission offer through the College admission portal/email.
- (b) The admission fee shall be collected only through the College-approved online payment gateway integrated with the College admission portal.
- (c) Upon successful payment, an online fee receipt shall be generated automatically.
- (d) The College Accounts Branch shall maintain a daily record of the fees collected.
- (e) The collected fees shall be reconciled and remitted to the University in accordance with the prescribed financial procedures and timelines.
- (f) No cash payment shall be accepted.

4. Registration/Application Fee:

- (a) No registration or application fee shall be charged from candidates who have already registered on the University of Delhi admission portal for the academic session 2026–27.

- (b) However, in respect of candidates who have not registered on the University admission portal, the College seeks permission to charge the prescribed application fee of ₹250 from UR/OBC-NCL/EWS candidates and ₹100 from SC/ST/PwBD candidates, subject to the approval of the University.
 - (c) The Registration fees must be sent to the concerned Finance Branch, University of Delhi.
 - (d) The candidates shall pay the prescribed University admission fee only after an offer of admission has been made to them.
5. A programme-wise and category-wise daily admission and vacancy report shall also be submitted to the University for its record and monitoring.
