

Number of entries from one college: Not more than 2

- The dance performance should be classical and should be recognised by SANGEET NATAK ACADEMY (Kathak, Bharatnatyam, Odissi, Kuchipudi, Manipuri, Kathakali, Mohiniyattam, Sattriya).
- -The performance must include introduction of the participants and the dance form they will perform.
- -The duration of the performance should be of 4-6 minutes.
- -If the participants exceed the time limit, then only the first 6 minutes will be considered.
- -Any classical music is allowed. Bollywood songs are not allowed.
- -Sitting choreography is not allowed.
- -Use of props is not allowed. Nrityam does not promote the use of glitters, powder or any inflammatory substances.
- -Any inappropriate act will lead to immediate disqualification of the participant.
- -Non adherence to the rules will lead to immediate disqualification.
- -The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

The participants sent a video of 4-6 minutes of them performing any one form of Indian Classical dance recognised under Sangeet Natak academy. There were about




