From the total selected 11 participants, the competition was attended by 10 participants and many interested audience through the online medium of Google meet with the link https://meet.google.com/bgy-ieok-afp. The introductory note and rules of competition were stated by Pourushi Pundil and Zeenat, Students of B.A. (H.) English III year. The program was concluded with the Vote of Thanks delivered by Dr. Chaandreyi Mukherjee, Assistant Professor of Department of English.










