‘Candid Conversations Over Coffee’ (National Panel Discussion)

Ennoia- The Debating Society of Vivekananda College, University of Delhi, organised a Two Day National Event, Kṛṣatva on 1-2 October 2021.

The National Panel Discussion ‘Candid Conversations Over Coffee’ was conducted on 1 October 2021 from 3.30 p.m. onwards on Google Meet platform with the link <https://meet.google.com/wor-zfng-yzv> and was also broadcasted on Youtube with the link <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hAKXWdUOoOQ>.

The competition was hosted by teacher coordinator, Dr. Chaandreyi Mukherjee, and was moderated by Priyanshi Bhatnagar, President and Ananya Mehrotra, Vice President of Ennoia. 27 participants from all over India had sent their write-ups on “one world, one government” along with their registrations. Participants, thoughtfully and perceptively responded to the cues with a lot of empathy, sensitivity and open-mindedness, as well as with strong factual details and examples from all over the world. The first of its kind for the Debating Society, this event was an enthralling
