



1. The dance performance should be classical and should be recognized by SANGEET NATAK ACADEMY (Kathak, Bharatnatyam, Odissi, Kuchipudi, Manipuri, Kathakali, Mohiniyattam, Sattriya).

2. The duration of the performance should be of 4-5 minutes. If the participants exceed the time limit, then only the first 5 minutes will be considered.

3. Any classical music is allowed. Bollywood songs are not allowed. Sitting choreography is not allowed.

4. Use of props is not allowed. Nrityam does not promote the use of glitters, powder or any inflammatory substances.

5. Participants need to bring their music in pendrive and in audio format in their mobile phones.



• The skit should be simple with no offensive language and should not hurt religious sentiments. Any sexist, caste - religion based comments is strictly prohibited.





8.To carry a college Id card is compulsory.



- 16.Any sexist, caste & religion based comments are strictly prohibited.


