
Hunar 2022- 23

Summary:

Ennoia, the Debating society of Vivekananda College, University of Delhi held an extempore debate competition on the theme 'Wonders_of_India/ अद्भुत भारत' as a part of Pallavi, the Annual Fest of the college. The competition was held on January 13, 2023, at the Sharda Hall.

The event received enthusiastic participation from various colleges. As per the rules of extempore, teams of two were shown the topic on spot and were given 5 minutes to prepare and 4 minutes (2 minutes each) deliver. The student coordinators for the event were Hemayushi and Garima and the anchors were Nidhi and Deepti. The event was judged by Dr. Anchala Paliwal, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Vivekananda College and Ms. Sheena Lama, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Lakshmibai College. Organised by: Students' Union Advisory Committee


