### 1. Internal Complaints' Committee (ICC)'s Policy Document

Internal Complaints' Committee (ICC) of Vivekananda College was formed under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace, Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act, 2013, (Hereinafter referred to as the Act). The Act provides protection against sexual harassment of women at workplaces and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment. This Act was adapted by the UGC to be followed by institutions of higher learning. Vivekananda College follows UGC Regulations 2015 regarding Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and students in Higher Educational Institutions.

The Act asserts that, no woman shall be subject to sexual harassment at any workplace. As per the Act, sexual harassment includes any one or more of the following unwelcome acts or behaviour (whether directly or by implication) namely:

- Physical contact and advances
- A demand or request for sexual favour
- Making sexually coloured remarks
- Showing pornography

The following circumstances, among other circumstances, if occur or is present in relation to or connected with any act or behaviour of sexual harassment may amount to sexual harassment:

- Implied or explicit promise of preferential treatment in her employment
- Implied or explicit threat of detrimental treatment in her employment
- Implied or explicit threat about her present or future employment
- Interference with her work or creating an intimidating or offensive or hostile work environment for her; or Humiliating treatment likely to affect her health or safety. शालाम दिल्ली

Complaints of Sexual Harassment: Any aggrieved woman/victim may make, in writing a complaint of sexual harassment at workplace to the ICC. ICC is a quasi-judicial body formed and work independently to work towards prevention of sexual harassment and handle complaints, if any following proper procedures Anyone found guilty shall be punished in accordance with the UGC Regulations 2015, in this regard. ICC, Vivekananda College is committed to creating the College a sexual harassment free institution and to promote gender sensitivity among students and teaching and non-teaching faculty. Therefore, it has proactively undertaken various programmes and activities for gender sensitization and awareness.

### 2. Counseling Cell

This year the main goals of counseling Cell of Vivekananda college (University of Delhi), was to create awareness about mental health, to accept oneself, to work on different mental health issues, give one to one counseling sessions, to provide a comfort space for students to talk freely. Various experiential activities were conducted with the guidance of Dr. Salma Seth, Convenor, and Ms. Mala Vohra Khanna, Clinical Psychologist along with the student Coordinator, Yashika. Even the events like 'World Mental Health Day' was celebrated in the college along with students from different disciplines where an activity on "Love and Kindness" was organized for the students which involved picking up a dare from a bowl of chits and had to carry it out there only. For example, one student had to dare to call her loved one and say 'I Love You'. Another student picked up a dare to buy a coffee/ tea for anyone present there. Another task was to write a positive message/ quote for the other students as their well- wishers.

"Self- talk activity" was conducted where students were shown mirrors and then asked to write under the sections 'I AM--', 'I AM GRATEFUL FOR--' and 'MY BIGGEST FEAR--', this was done to make these students know better about themselves. Another activity was "Self- love/ care" where students were asked to write down how they dealt with the physical, emotional, spiritual and social domains of self care. This was done to make the students aware about the new ways to deal with such common pressures.

Besides these activities, workshops were also held to create awareness about mental health issues and emotional well-being. Workshop on "Over thinking: How to Handle It" where our resource person Ms. Mala started by explaining the term 'over thinking' as well as its detrimental effects and how to cope it. After conducting a short activity she suggested some effective solutions to overcome over thinking. Another workshop conducted was on the topic, "Trauma" where Ms. Mala Vohra Khanna first gave an introduction of the topic and then proceeded with the physical, emotional and psychological responses. She then, also, explained the reasons behind this and its effects. Some students came forward to ask questions at the end of the workshop, too, to get a better understanding and to clear some doubts.

Future plans are made to promote physical, emotional and psychological well-being of students where topics such as stress, grief, nutritional health and other mental health issues would be taken up in workshops and activities.





### 3. Political Science

The department **of Political Science** had also organised a counselling session on mental health called '**Mending Relationships'**. The renowned Doctor, Dr.Siddharth (IBHAS) took the session on 15th September 2022 at 11 am, Sharda Hall.

### Seminar on Acid Attack: Trauma and Coping

Date: 20th April 2023

Venue: Vivekananda College, University of Delhi Organizer: Applied Psychology Department

### **Introduction:**

The seminar on "Acid Attack: Trauma and Coping" held at Vivekananda College, University of Delhi, aimed to shed light on the distressing issue of acid attacks and its psychological impact on survivors. ### **Session 3: Understanding Acid Attacks and Trauma**

In this session, Dr. Mittal delved deeper into the topic, presenting a comprehensive understanding of acid attacks and their traumatic consequences. She discussed the prevalence of acid attacks in India, citing statistics from the National Crime Bureau (NCRB) and emphasized the need for a holistic approach encompassing medical, legal, and psychological support for survivors.

### Session 4: Coping Strategies and Rehabilitation

Dr. Mittal shared her research findings on the coping strategies employed by acid attack survivors. She highlighted the importance of social support, rehabilitation programs, and counseling services in facilitating survivors' recovery and empowerment. Drawing from her qualitative research, she presented compelling case studies that showcased the resilience and determination of survivors in overcoming adversity.

### **Session 5: Legal and Socio-Economic Challenges**

This session focused on the legal and socio-economic hurdles faced by acid attack survivors.

Dr. Mittal shed light on the legal frameworks in place to address acid attacks and the gaps that still exist. She discussed the financial implications of such attacks and emphasized the need for improved access to justice and economic opportunities for survivors.

### **Session 6: Q&A and Interactive Discussion**

The seminar concluded with an engaging Q&A session, allowing the audience to seek clarification and share their perspectives. Participants raised thought-provoking questions on the role of society in combating acid attacks, the importance of education and awareness, and the need for stricter legal measures. Dr. Mittal provided insightful responses, encouraging a dialogue on possible solutions and avenues for further research.

Conclusion: The seminar on "Acid Attack: Trauma and Coping" provided a platform for academic discourse, awareness, and dialogue on a pressing issue that affects countless individuals in India. Dr. Shalini Mittal's expertise, research, and advocacy efforts shed light on the psychological impact of acid attacks and highlighted the importance of a holistic approach to support survivors. The event successfully fostered a sense of empathy, education, and empowerment among the attendees, encouraging them to take action and contribute to a more inclusive and compassionate society.














### 2. Pad Donation Drive

On the 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, Enactus Vivekananda College under the guidance of Dr. Sandhya Jain, Convenor and Dr. Shafaq Zareen, Faculty Coordinator organised a pad distribution drive where the team was successful in distributing a total of 200 pads among the women who are located in the slum areas of Jhilmil. We aimed to help the financially constrained communities and the underprivileged section of society to help get access to safe menstrual products who often face stigma and shame around menstruation, which leads to discrimination in the society. Due to a lack of education regarding menstruation, the younger group of girls end up missing school when their cycle begins which affects their well-being in the long run. Team Enactus VNC addressed this issue through a pad distribution drive. Our team discussed and helped in resolve the issues and the problems the women face during periods by empowering them to take control over their health and providing them with the necessary resources and support which would enable them to manage their periods with dignity.






### 7. Internal Complaints Committee for Sexual Harassment

### 8. SOCDC - RIGHTS OF ACID ATTACK VICTIMS AND SERVICES


