


Celebration of Van Mahotsav Week

Webinar on Alcohol Addiction make people to doterrible things




Day 2: Zreniye-2 (Film Screening)


Day 3 : वार्तालाप-1





It was truly an informative, interactive and insightful session. Here are some of the glimpses of the event-






PPT Presentation on World Sustainable Energy Day

On the occasion of International Yoga Day




CYBER SECURITY WEBINAR





Students got the opportunity to know about the importance of vegan diet and its advantages such as, it promotes weight loss, it reduces the risk of heart disease by lowering cholesterol levels, lowers the chances of getting certain types of cancer such as colon cancer.



One Day Awareness and Sensitisation Programme on Ageing with Dignity & Promoting Intergenerational Bonding

On 4th March 2022, The Social Outreach and Community Development Committee of Vivekananda College organized a 'One Day Awareness and Sensitisation Programme on Ageing with Dignity & Promoting Intergenerational Bonding' in association with Anugraha, a national NGO under the convenorship of Dr. Sandhya Jain and faculty coordinator Dr. Shafaq Zareen. The event took place in the big auditorium of Vivekananda College and was opened with an invigorating speech by Dr. Hina Nandrajog who conveyed, "Ageing is not a choice, and it is inevitable".

Dr. Abha, a representative from Anugraha, pitched the various issues senior citizens face and explained the multiple activities Anugraha has conducted to make a change for the same like organizing age-friendly programs, running day care centers, holding picnics, and aiding them with healthcare. She explained how the population group ageing above eighty has been on a constant rise and the recent Covid-19 crisis has enlightened everyone about the medical and healthcare standing of India. Over that, the crucial issue is maintaining the quality of life when someone ages, as when a person grows old they become feeble and are often in need of caretakers or supervision. Senior citizens realizing their worth and saving money for their future goes a long way in improving their condition. Above all, she explained how Anugraha as an agency for old-age care focuses on the three aspects of sensitization, awareness generation, and capacity building.

Ms. Rajkumari, Vice President of Anugraha, followed next with her eloquent speech. She wove a beautiful tale about the bond that fosters between a child and the elders of a household. The respect that settles within children from youth remains within them throughout their life. She showed how both the younger generation and the older generation have to make an active effort to prosper a healthy and respectful relationship. The tender hands that held us through the most delicate phase of our life, the same wrinkled hands need our support when they reach their fragile stage, and Ms. Rajkumari portrayed the importance of caring for our elders and intergenerational bonding with noble ease. Ending her insightful speech with a poem that pierced straight through the hearts of the audience she conveyed a thousand things the elderly do for their children and how one remains indebted to them for the love and care they invested during their life. She finished with, "Inke toh ehsaan itne, hum gina sakte nahi" which directly deciphers elders making endless sacrifices for their children that stay uncountable.


Next Dr. Vanita Sondhi, Associate Professor of Applied Psychology, spoke up on the issues senior citizens face as they try to age with dignity. She shared her situation and helped the audience understand how little joys can make a big difference in the life of an elderly person. She presented the question, "How long would one like to live?" to her audience which brought out

interesting perspectives on the topic of ageing with grace. She explained how the definition of dignity differs from person to person and broadened the horizon of discussion by talking about 'Successful Ageing'. Quoting Ruskin Bond she said, "How you construct life and think about it, how you keep yourself busy and how you make life meaningful - that is what matters." Through it, she elucidated upon the eminence of genuine relationships. Therefore, she accentuated the factor of happiness that is central to successful ageing. With a balance between physical activities, active engagement with life, and the acceptance of giving away control elderly people can pursue happiness and maintain their cognitive functions because being disabled never snatches the prospect of a fulfilled life.

Following a brief fun chit-chat session with Ms. Rajkumari, the last speaker of the day Dr. Rajesh Gupta, Director of Innovative Institute of Law, graced the audience with his presence. His session delved into a lawyer's point of view on the aspect of senior citizens' ageing. He explained the working of the legal bodies like the judiciary and how the prerogative of law functions. He explained about the 'Senior Citizen Act' issued by the Parliament in 2007 that focuses on the welfare of senior citizens. Through this act, even if parents have transferred their property to their children, it is possible to acquire it back by issuing a complaint to the Magistrate. He also broached upon the various sub-provisions set in place by the legislature as remedies for the setbacks people may face as they age. The government has also built residential homes and arranged facilities to provide medical care to uphold the Right to Life and personal liberty of senior citizens. He also explained how the constitution includes a dignified cremation for the elderly under the law. He concluded his speech by leaving everyone filled with knowledge and something to ponder upon.

Dr. Sandhya Jain, the convener of the Social Outreach and Community Development Committee, delivered a vote of thanks to the esteemed guests, which was followed by a brief certificate distribution ceremony. The event ended on a note of harmony where the attendees developed a better sense of understanding for the elderly. 147 students attended this programme.







AZAL:THE FUN AND FUNDRAISING EVENT


Fundraiser event includes entertaining performances by Ms. Prachi Joshi, classical vocalist from
