- 5. Slogans must reflect the given theme provided on the spot.
- 6. Slogans must be original and handmade; plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- 7. Slogans must not be derogatory, and not contain any content that is inappropriate, or that promotes hatred against any group or person.
- 8. Participants will be judged based on relevance to the theme, originality, and creativity.

9. The decision of the Jury is final and binding.

Rules for Painting Competition:

1. Participants have full freedom to utilize any mediums, techniques, and styles for their

paintings.

2. The dimensions of the painting must adhere to A3 size paper.

3. Participants are responsible for bringing all necessary materials including A3 paper

and painting material.

4. The allotted time for painting will be 90 minutes.

5. Paintings must be original and created on the spot.

6. Evaluation criteria include theme interpretation, quality, complexity, artistic merit,

and overall presentation.

7. Painting must not contain any content that is inappropriate, or that promotes hatred

against any group or person.

8. The decision of the Jury is conclusive and binding.

Participation certificates will be given to all the participants.
