
Overall Sample Size:

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
Profile of participants:


1. Clarity of course objectives 927 responses




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


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19.2% (178) of the respondents feels that clarity on the course objective is excellent, 34% (315) respondent finds it very good, 36% (334) finds it good, 8.7% (81) respondent feels that the clarity is fair, and 2% (19) respondents feel that more efforts need to be made in order to have a clear delivery of various courses.


2. Timely course completion 927 responses






4. Extent to which the course generates interest in subject area 927 responses



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


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

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5. Depth of course content 927 responses



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


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6. Relevance of course content to real life 927 responses



Alumnus (Total Responses - 74)



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


15.2% (141) of the total respondents feel that course content is excellent in connecting theory with practical life. 29.9% (277) and 31.7% (294) of the respondents are pretty satisfied about theoretical teaching having relevance in practical life. 18% (167) of the respondents find fair connection between theoretical teaching and its real life relevance and 5.2% (48) feel more efforts need to be made to draw a connection between theoretical teaching and its real life relevance.


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7. Methods of assessment of student performance 927 responses



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
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8. Ability of the course to foster higher learning 927 responses





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



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

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
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10. Curriculum has the potential for self learning 927 responses




