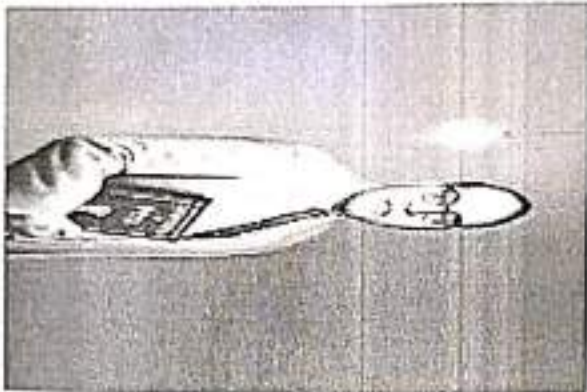



वेबिनार 'रीतिकाल एक नवीन दृष्टि'

हिंदी विभाग की ओर से वेबिनार शृंखला में 18 मई 2020 को 'रीतिकाल एक नवीन दृष्टि' विषय पर डॉ. मुकेश गर्ग का विशेष व्याख्यान आयोजित किया गया। जूम एप पर 5.30 बजे शाम को आयोजित इस कार्यक्रम में विषय प्रवेश करते हुए डॉ. सरोज कुमारी ने गंभीर प्रश्न उठाए। उन्होंने कहा कि 1850 की परम्परा को लोग रीतिकाल में क्यों नहीं रखते? उन्होंने डॉ. मुकेश गर्ग का परिचय देते हुए बताया कि वे संगीत और साहित्य दोनों में सिद्धहस्त हैं। डॉ. गर्ग ने रीतिकाल पर आधुनिक दृष्टि से सोचने की परिपाटी दी है। महविद्यालय की प्राचार्या डॉ. हिना नंदराजोग ने स्वागत भाषण देते हुए हिंदी विभाग को इस आयोजन के लिए बधाई दी। उन्होंने कहा कि ऐसे आयोजन छात्रों के लिए बहुत उपयोगी सक्षित होते हैं।

डॉ. मुकेश गर्ग ने रीतिकाल की प्राथमिक चिंता से अपनी बात शुरू की। उन्होंने कहा कि विध्यार्थी आखिर कैसे रीतिकाल के संकट से मुक्त हों? इसकी भाषा ब्रज है और हम खड़ी बोली वाले हो गए हैं। रीतिकाल को अश्लील कहा गया। स्त्रियों की छवि शुरू में बहुत अच्छी नहीं रही है। सूफी काव्यधारा में स्त्रियों को महत्व दिया गया है। वहाँ स्त्री में अल्लाह का नूर झलकता है, यह बड़ी बात है। भक्तिकाल में तुलसीदास स्त्री को बहुत ज्यादा सम्मान भाव नहीं देते हैं। सुरदास ने प्रेम के धरातल पर स्त्रियों को थोड़ी स्वतंत्रता दी है। मीरा के यहाँ पग में घुंघरू बाँधने जैसे कर्म को इज्जतदार पेशे में बदलने कि दृढ़ता है। रीतिकाल में स्त्रियों के मनोभाव को अच्छे से चित्रित किया गया है।

डॉ. मुकेश गर्ग ने कहा कि स्त्रियों ने अगर दरबारी कविता लिखी होती तो न्यायक भेद भी ज्यादा होता। उन्होंने रीतिकाल के आचार्यत्व को बड़े कर्म का निर्वहण माना। आचार्यों ने खुद लक्षण बनाए और खुद ब्रजभाषा में कविता लिखी, यह अद्भुत है। वेबिनार में 150 लोग उपस्थित रहे। अंत में डॉ. रेणु साहनी ने अच्छे वक्तव्य के लिए डॉ. गर्ग की प्रशंसा करते हुए उपस्थित प्रतिभागियों का धन्यवाद किया।

AQAR Report

Taking forward the Government of India's initiative of "Poshan Maha Abhiyan", Health & Wellness Committee of Vivekananda College organized a 3-day Anemia Camp for all batches of college students in the month of September, 2019 from 25th to 27th. A team of well-experienced doctors and support staff from GTB Hospital, Nand Nagri, Delhi was present all the three days from 10 am to 4 pm along with the committee members in the foyer of the Big Auditorium. More than 1300 students were tested for anemia on all three days.

To ensure smooth-functioning of the camp and better coordination, all the college batches had been assigned specific dates for testing. On 25th September, all first year students were screened for anemia. On 26th September, all second year students were tested for the same, and on 27th September, all third year students as well as teaching and non-teaching staff were asked to come for the testing.

Students were not only tested for anemia but also given expert medical advice and suggested ways to keep anemia at bay. Some students who were found anemic upon testing were prescribed medicines containing iron and folic acid (IFA) and asked to follow a healthy and nutrient-rich diet.

Anemia is a condition in which a person has an insufficient number of red blood cells or quantity of haemoglobin, which reduces the capacity of their blood to carry oxygen. Normal haemoglobin for women is 12 gram per decilitre (g/dL) and men 13 g/dL.

Ever since the global pandemic surfaced in the form of novel-Coronavirus and colleges and universities were shut to prevent spread and promote safety of students and teachers alike, Health & Wellness Committee made available counseling to every student in such stressful times. Students are counseled on a regular basis to keep a healthy routine and follow Covid-19 guidelines.

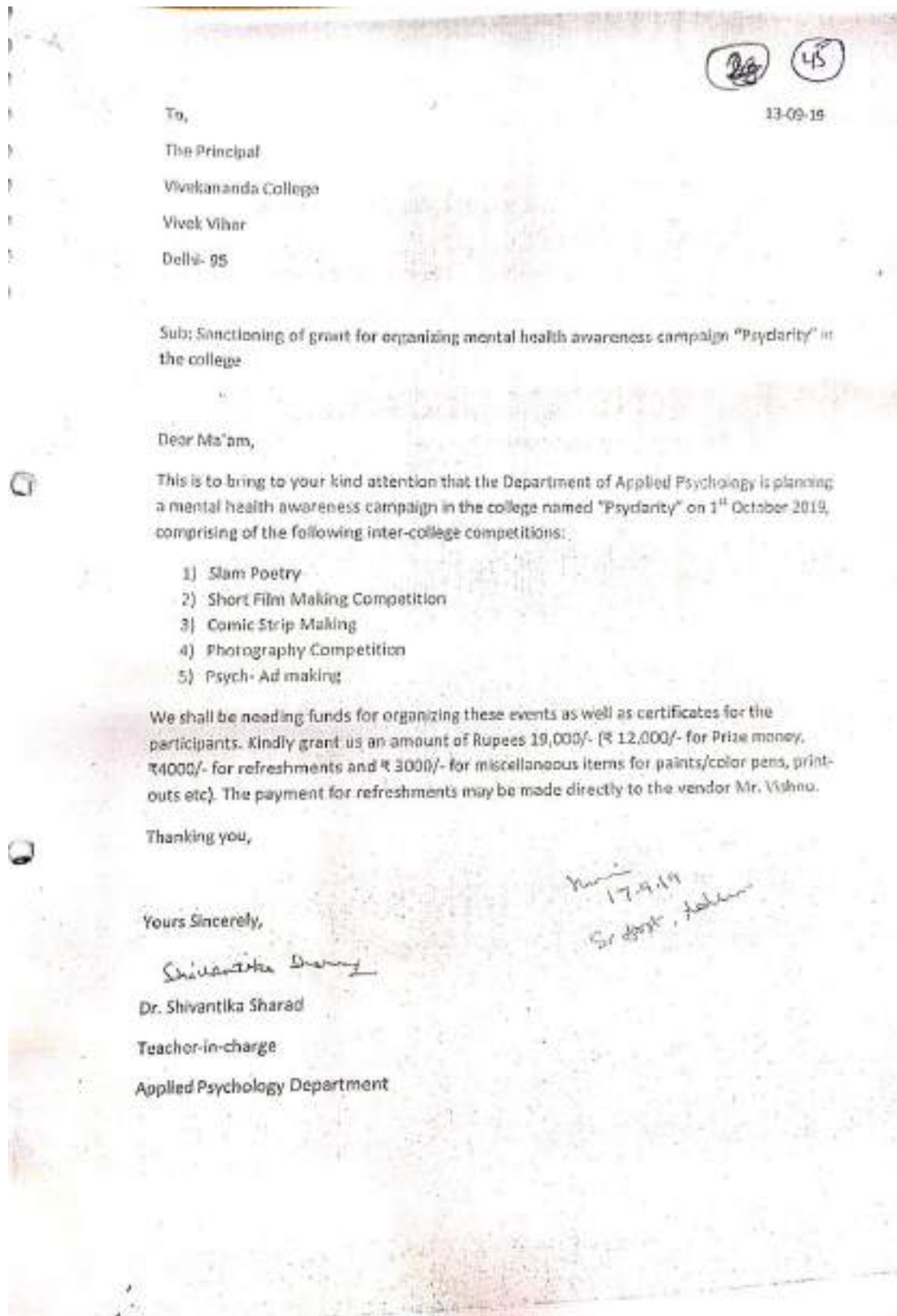

Industrial visit to Parle G

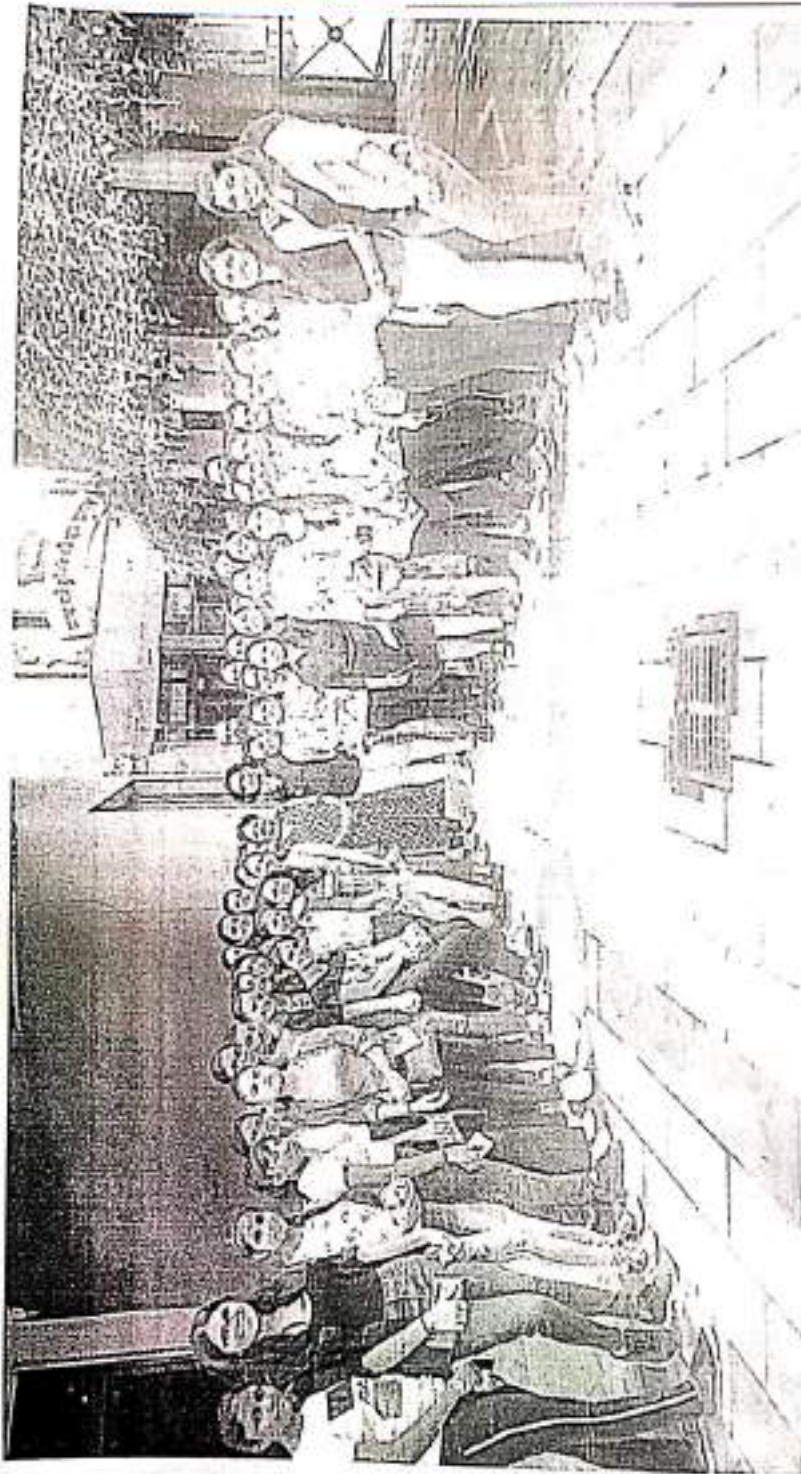
Around sixty students were taken on an industrial visit to Parle-G Biscuit Private Limited, Bahadurgarh, Haryana on 17th August, 2019. Parle G is a very reputed biscuit and confectionary manufacturing company which has headquarters at Mumbai and plants at Bahadurgarh, Haryana and Neemrana, Rajasthan, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu. The first plant of Parle G was set up in 1929 and the plant visited by our students in Bahadurgarh was set up in 1939. The Parle name symbolizes quality, nutrition and great taste. With a reach spanning even the remotest villages of India, the company has definitely come a very long way since its inception. Parle G has been maintaining an oven which is best in Asia.

The students were taken to the factory in Bahadurgarh. They were escorted by the official who took them to the manufacturing unit and students got a chance to see the inside view of the factory where right from dough (the first input) to last stage i.e., packaging and how each step is performed mechanically. The students were also taken to the printing department. In one minute, lakhs of products can be manufactured by an efficient machine. The environment inside was aesthetic, pure and hygienic. The Parle G products are economically so affordable that these are marketed even in the remotest part of the country.

The visit ended with a vote of thanks from both the sides. Students were given packets of Parle wafers and delicious Mango Bites.

Overall, the activity was highly interactive and a great learning experience for the students on the concepts related to production and operations within a manufacturing plant. The combination of learning while having fun was made possible by seeing the assembly process in person, which, like many other topics, can be explained in the four walls of a classroom, but is made so much more effective when it is accessible and experienced by the learners. Through such field trips, we hope to cultivate practical learners by fueling their innate curiosity and encouraging them to understand in a hands-on way.

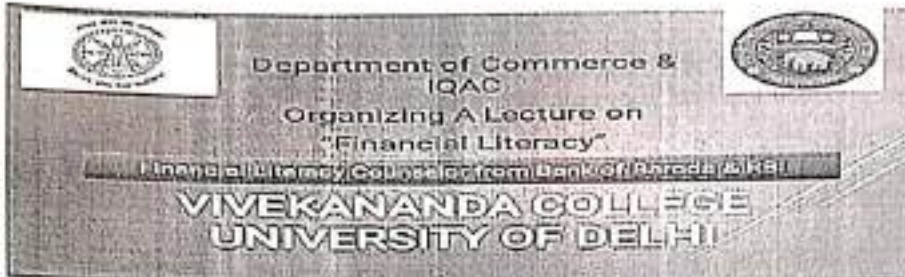
The field trip was an overall success with the students' enthusiastic response.

Overall, NSS volunteers have been spreading awareness about COVID-19 and its precautions through social media, posters, videos etc. on a daily basis.



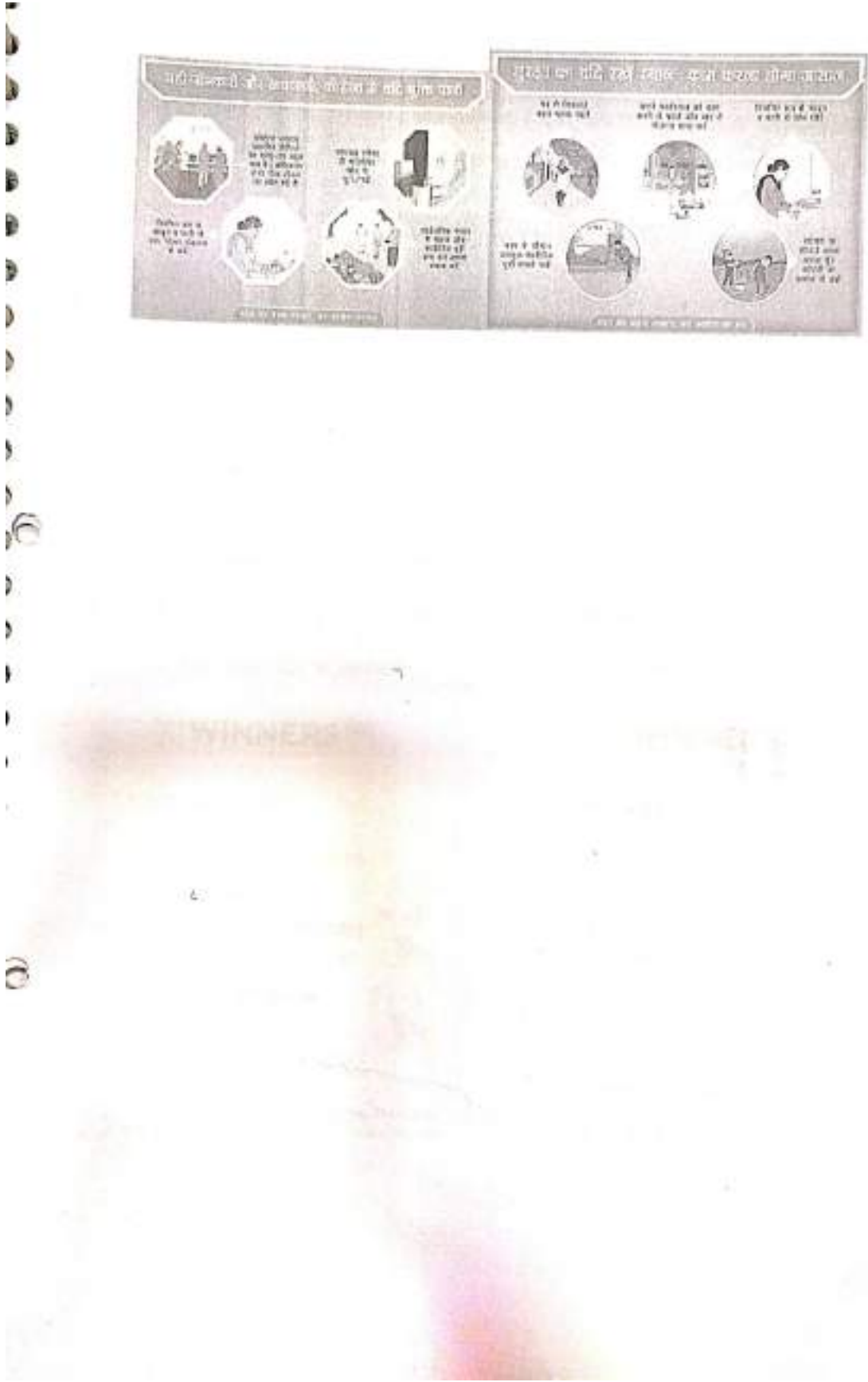
