Held on 08 January 2021


Platform: Google Meet



7. Workshop on Harmonium, Dhwani- the Indian music society of Vivekananda College:








12. Poster Making Competition - Forest and Livelihood Sustaining People and Planet, ecoclub, Vivekananda college:





18. In_Your_Words, Debating Society, Vivekananda college:



interjections to the best of their abilities. While the judges were calculating results the participants further discussed about social media amongst themselves and satiated each other's curiosity.



This year Zehniyat was conducted in online manner where the teams were invited with poster and the results will be announced on 9th April. 2021.



- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.





47. Doodle Art Making Workshop (14th August 2021)






