-The objective of this session was to discuss and explore various aspects of Photography and its technicalities.

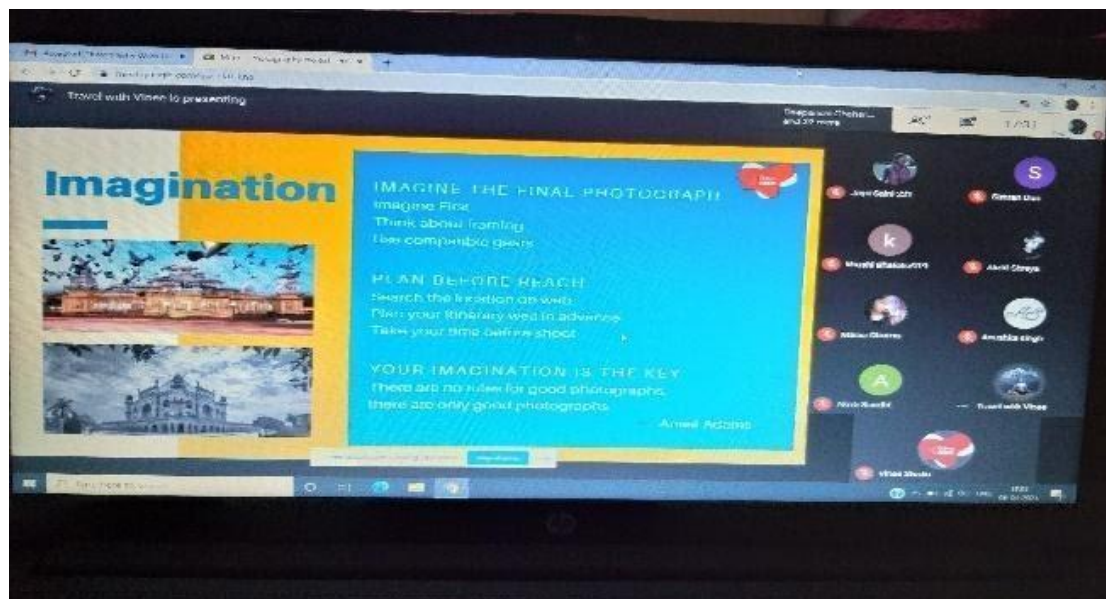
Mr. Virendra explained Meaning, Concept, Tips and Tricks etc. related to photography in a very informative and interesting manner.

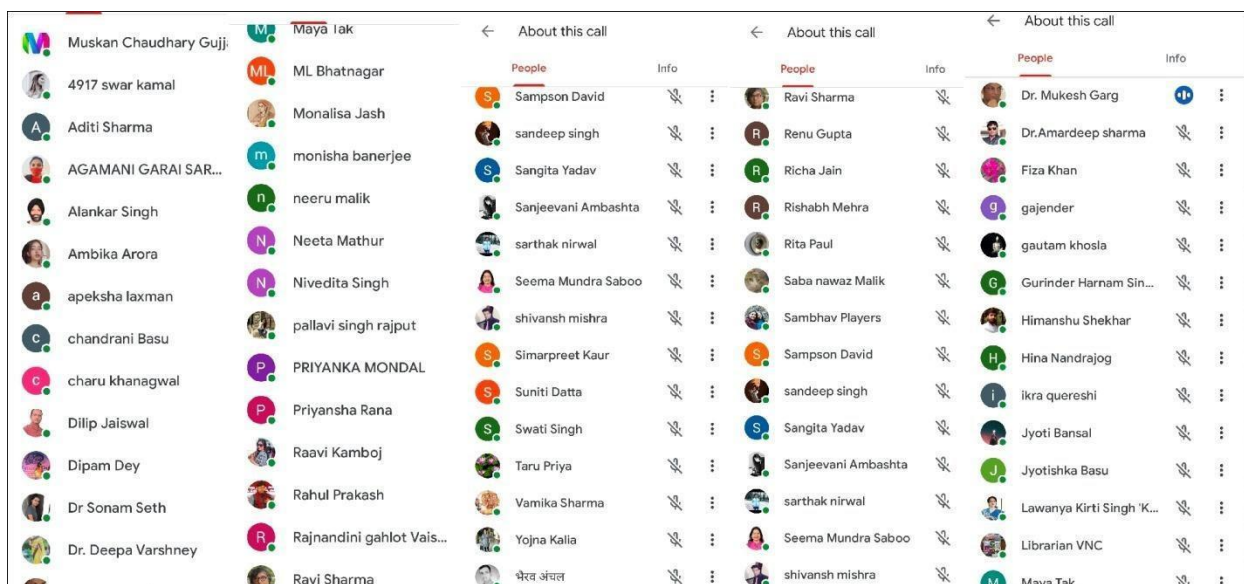
7. Workshop on Harmonium, Dhvani- the Indian music society of Vivekananda College:

8. National Webinar on 'Hindi Filomn Men Sangeet', Dhvani- the Indian music society of Vivekananda College:

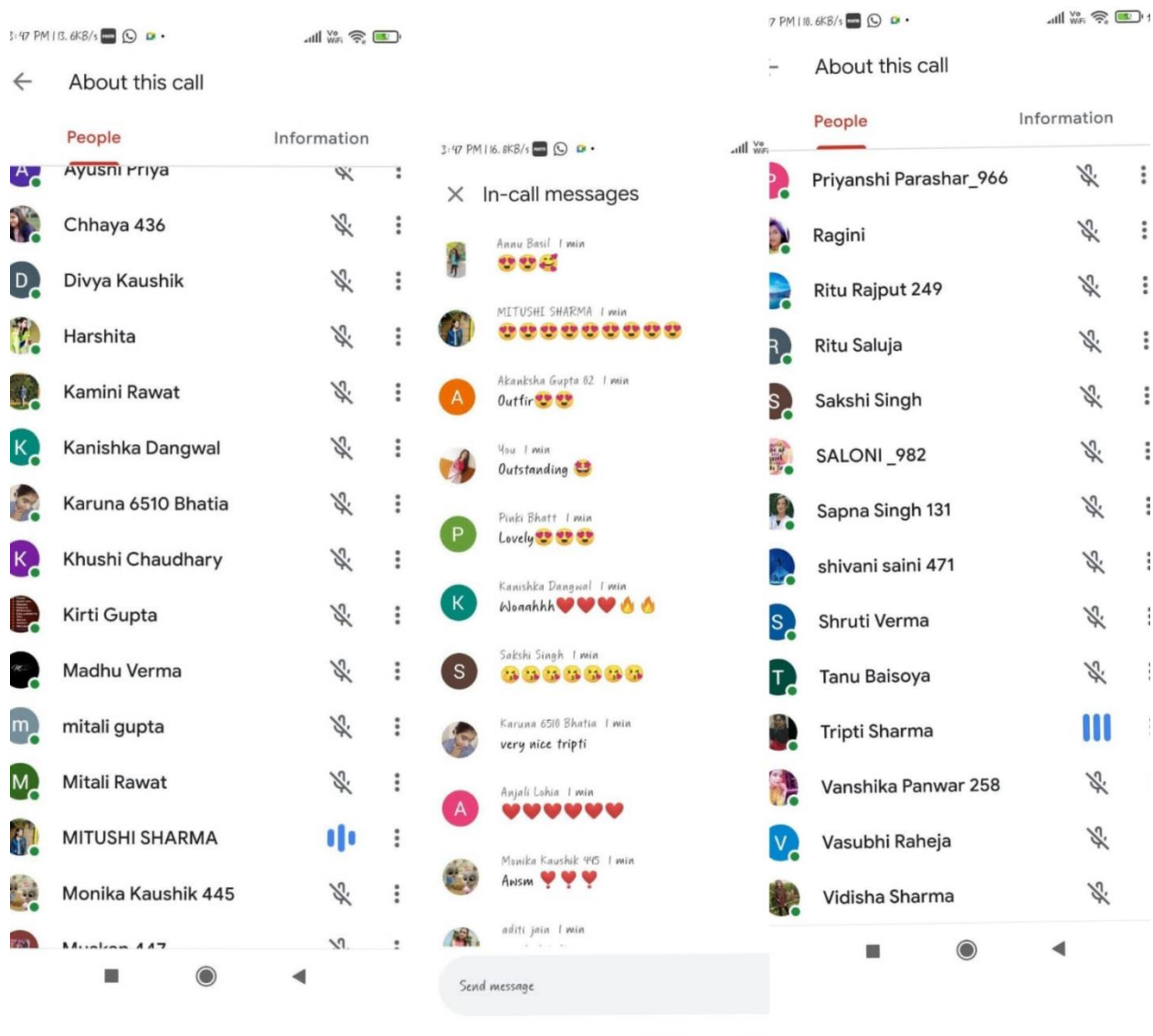
Music Department and Indian Music Society- Dhvani of Vivekanand College, University of Delhi celebrates 75 years of India's Independence: Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav by organizing a National Webinar on "हिंदी फिल्मों में संगीत" on 20th July, 2021 By Dr. Mukesh Garg, eminent musicologist and ex-faculty, Department of music and fine art, Delhi University. Dr. Deepa Varshney and Dr. Neeta Mathur were the convener of the webinar. The motive of webinar was to highlight the importance of music in Hindi films. Dr. Mukesh Garg explained how music plays its role in developing feelings, thoughts, connecting people of different backgrounds and soothing the mind of the people, in his speech he told how the music ties each other in a single thread. He appreciated the lyrics of the old music by quoting some songs like "namanu re namanu re, dagabaz tori batiya" song was originally sung by Lata Mangeshkar. The playback singers such as 'Lata Mangeshkar, Hemant Kumar, Asha Bhonsle, Kishor Kumar and Mohhamad Rafi were the mainstay of that time. He expressed his concern about the changing music in modern times. Earlier songs were successful eliciting emotions of love, sadness, happiness, joy. But now, music is losing its golden image. Modern music degenerated into sleaziness and vulgarity. The music of previous era was more beautifully organised but with the change of time, taste and aptitude of people also got changed. So people are enjoying rock songs and this is degrading the quality of music. To maintain the beauty of music a little change is required. At last, speaker was thanked for delivering such an informative and enlightening speech.

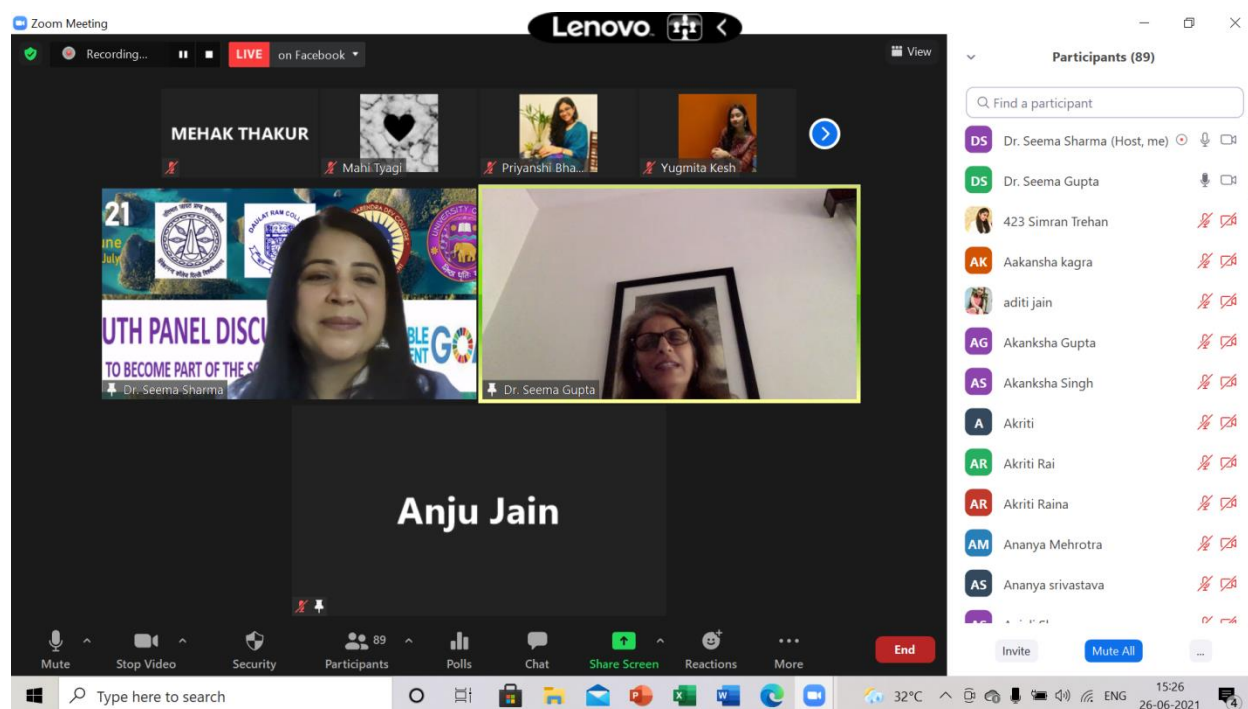

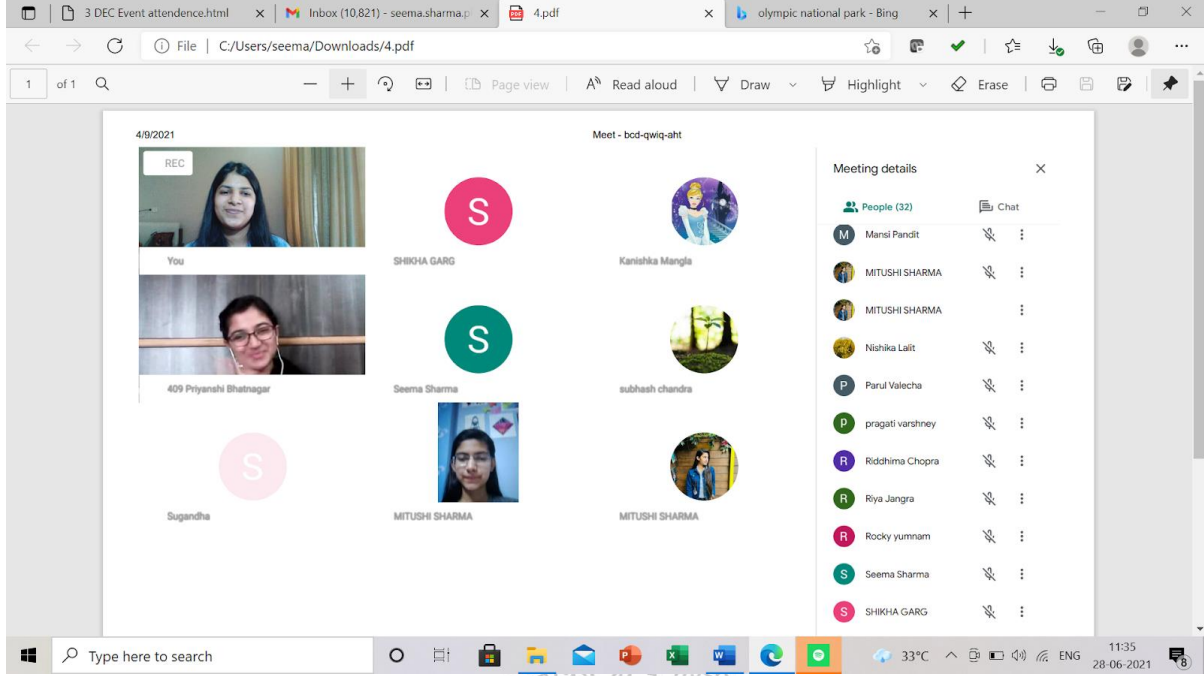
11. World Environment Day celebration 2021, Dept of Environment, Vivekananda college:

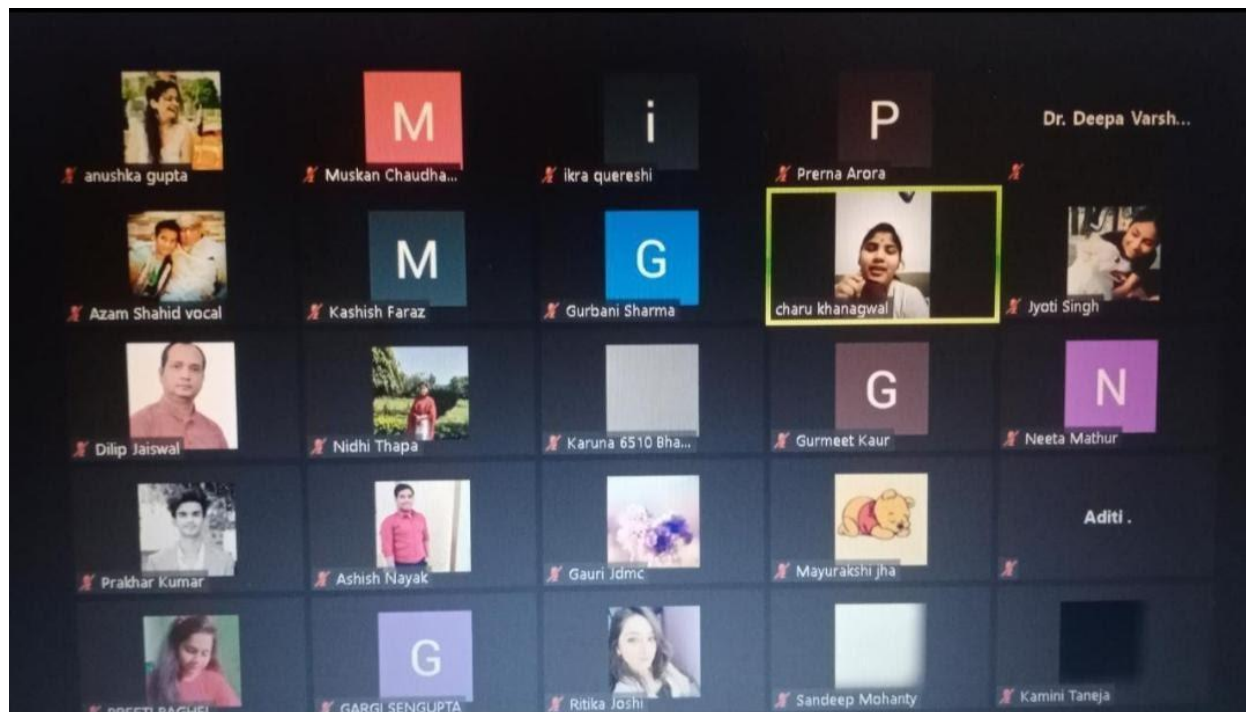

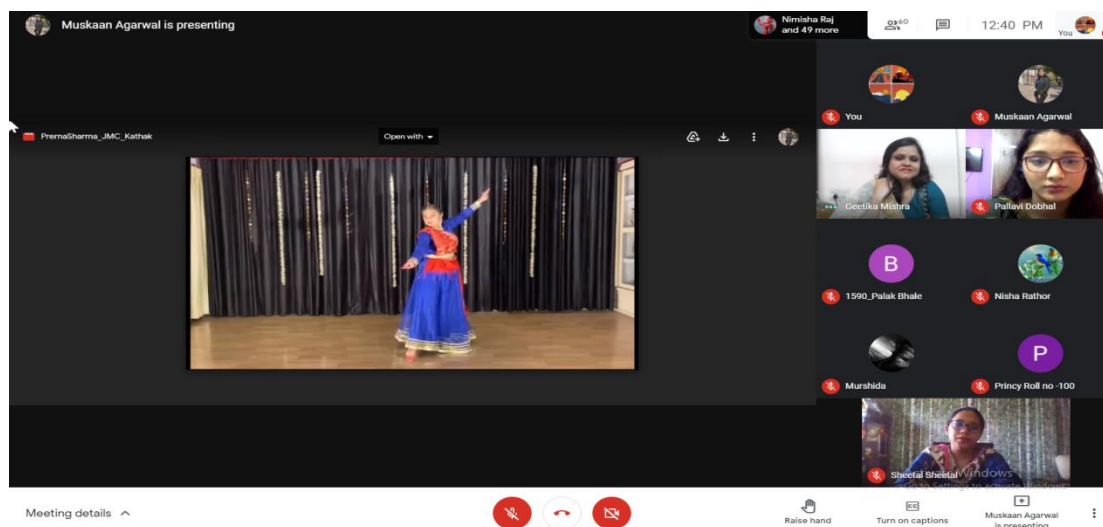
16. Shutter Up, Photography, CLICK'O'MANIA- The Photography Society, Vivekananda College:

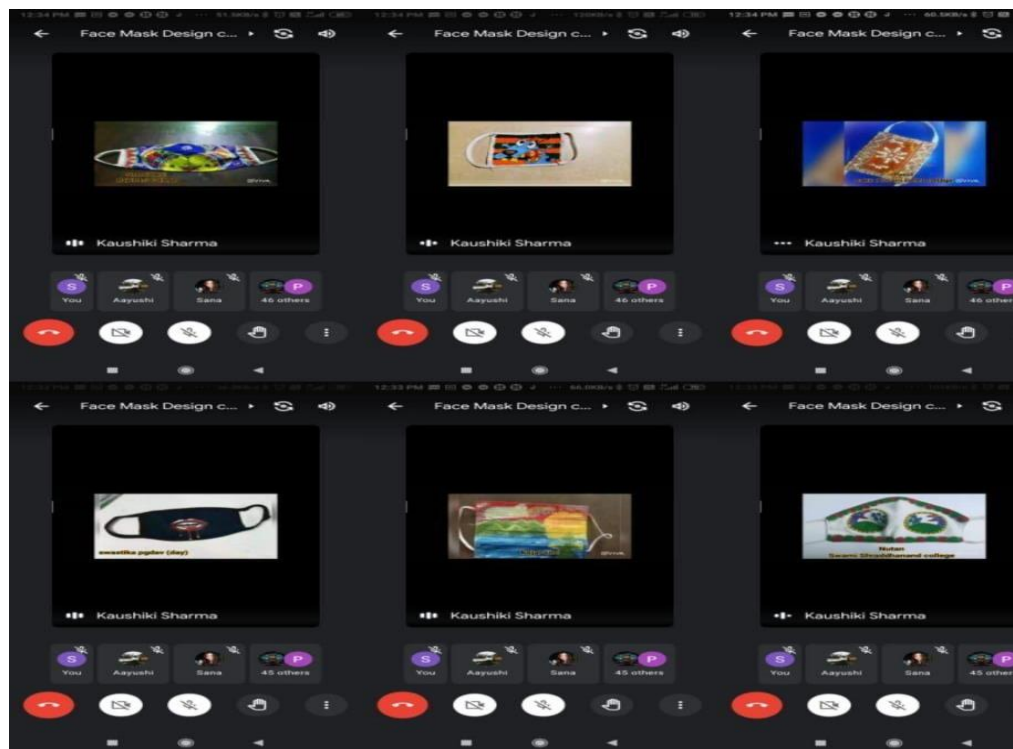




25. Face Mask Designing, Art and Craft Society, Vivekananda college:

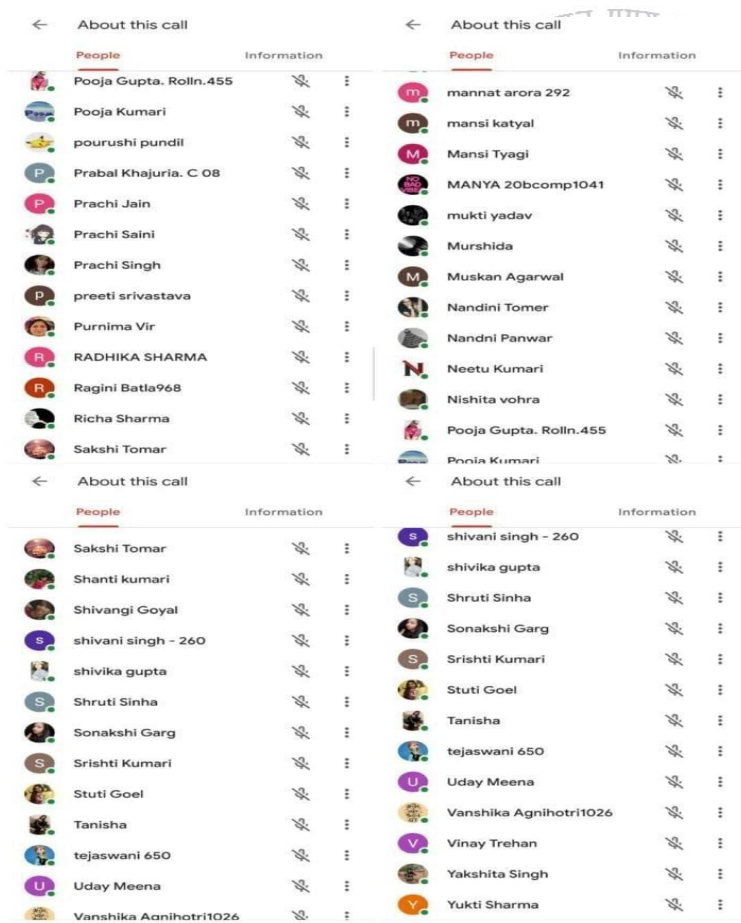

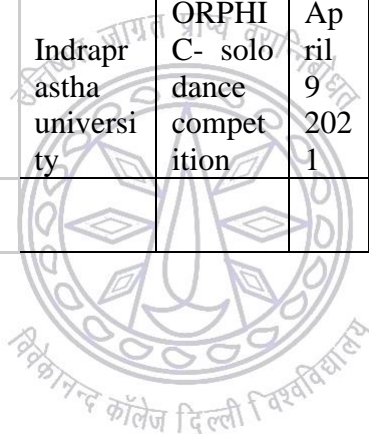

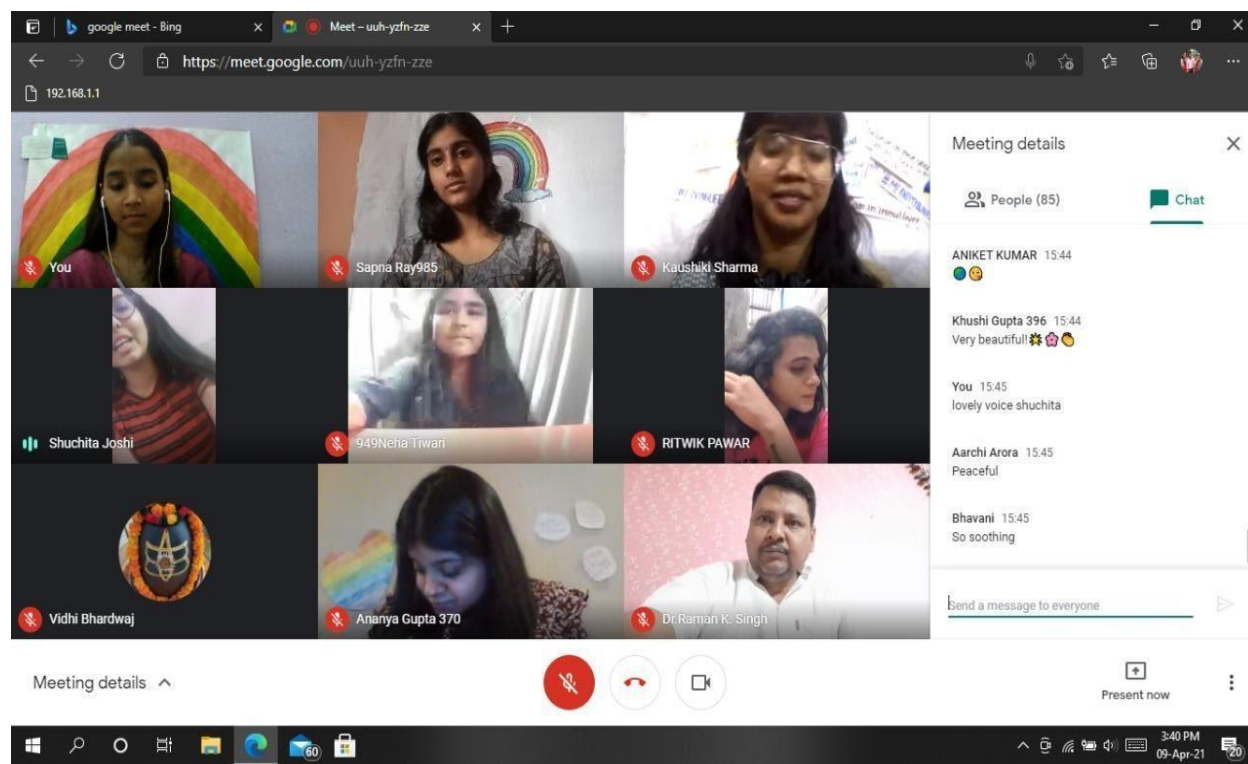
This year Zehniyat was conducted in online manner where the teams were invited with poster and the results will be announced on 9th April. 2021.

Following were the rules of the competition:

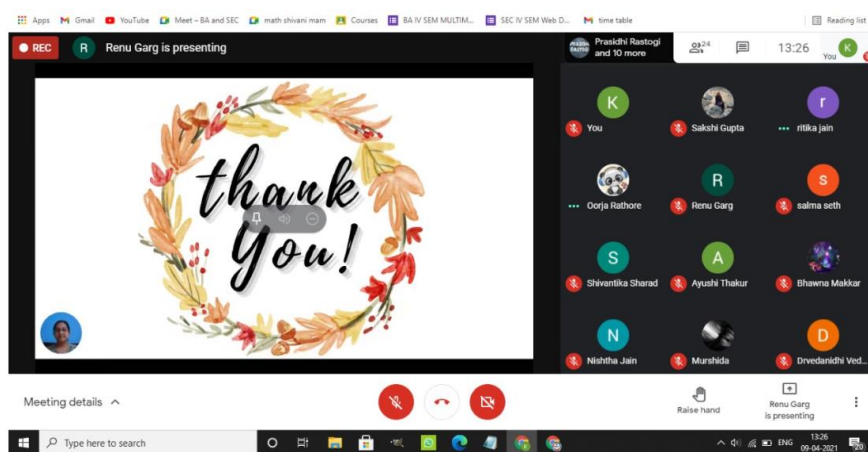
- It is an individual competition.

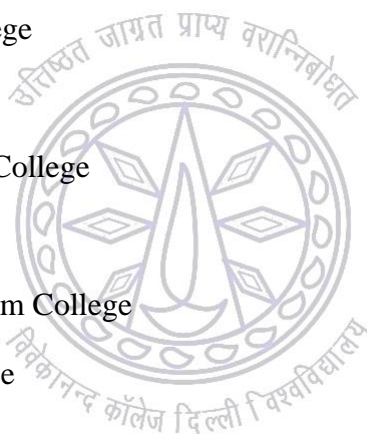

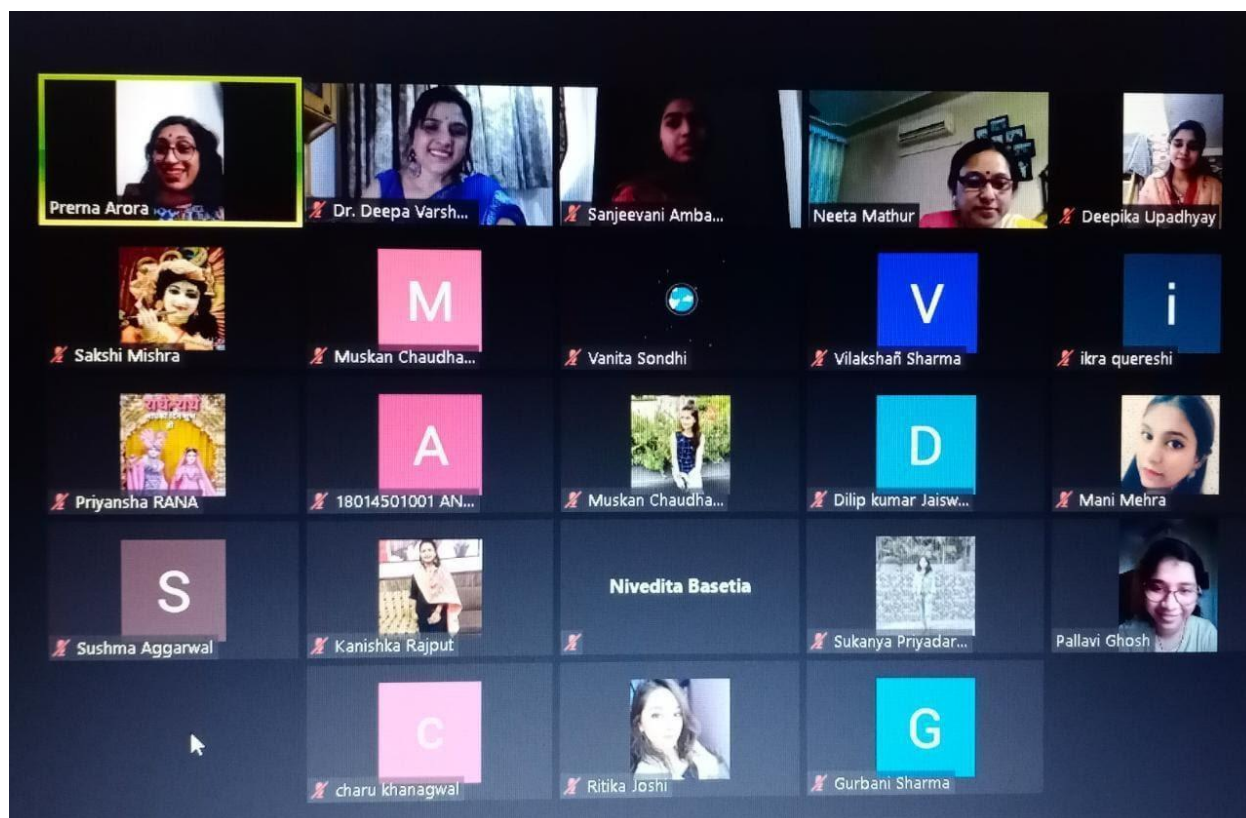

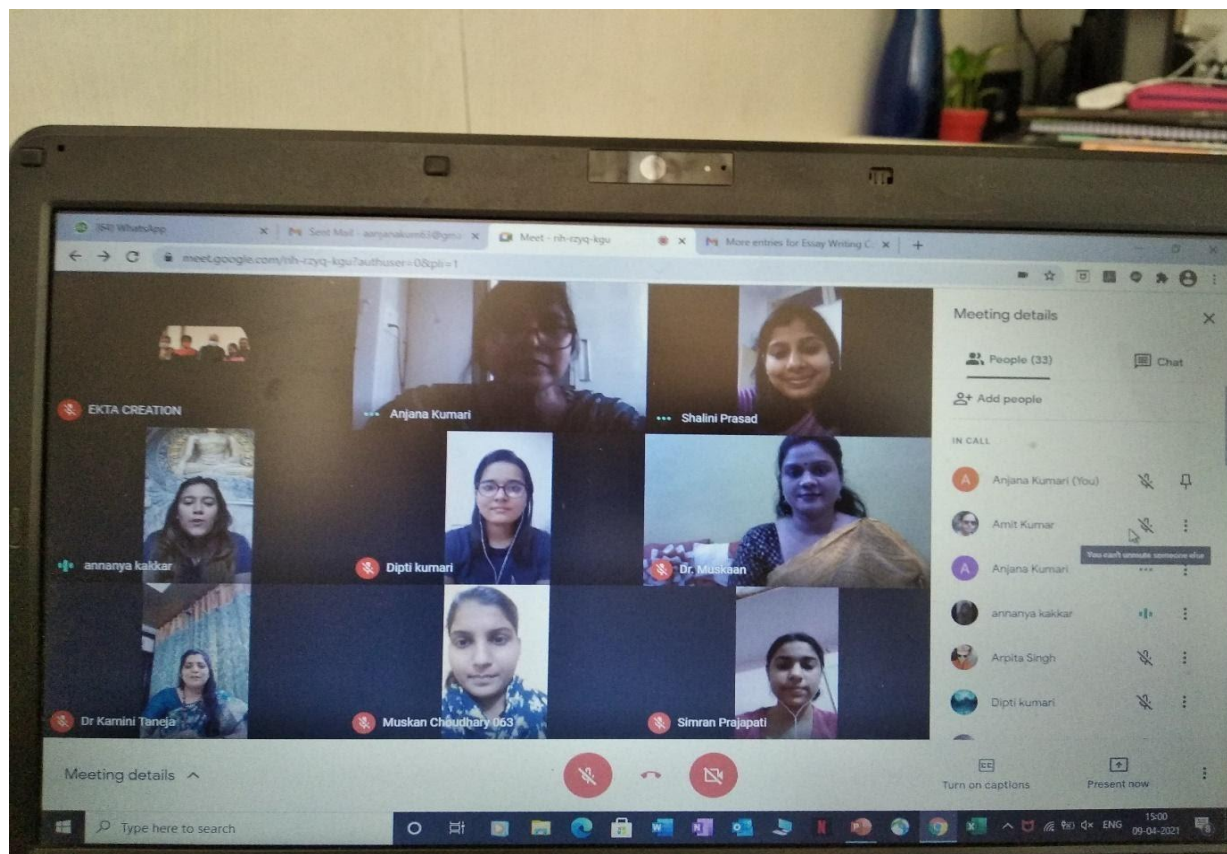

The Online Poster competition on Dandi March was held on 9th August 2021. 24 students participated in the competition.

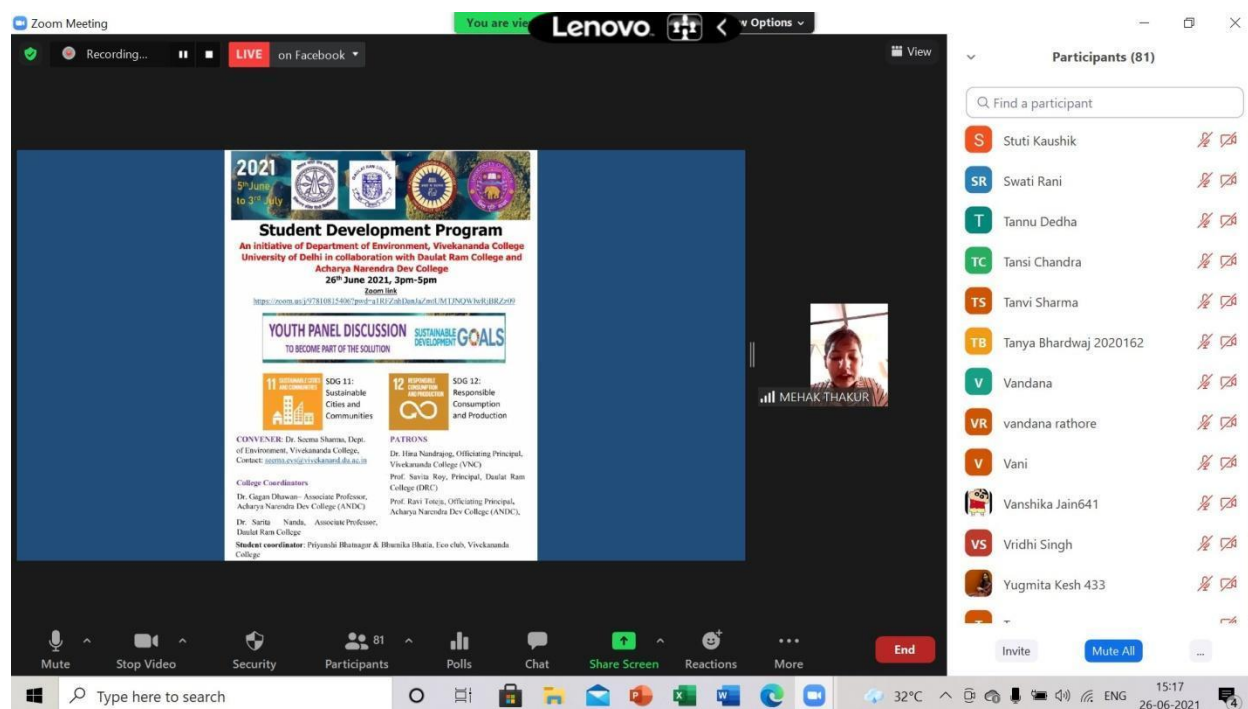
47. Doodle Art Making Workshop (14th August 2021)

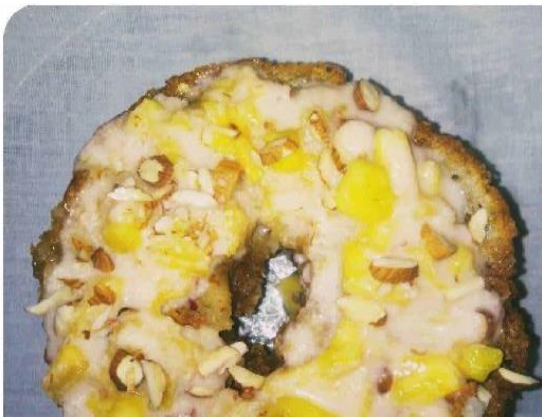

A total of 72 students registered in inter-college virtual quiz competition. A total of 61 people attended the event. Of these 5 were teachers of the college namely Mrs. Purnima Vir, Mrs. Seema Taneja, Dr. Sukhneet Suri, Dr. Kamini Taneja and Dr. Arushi Jain. A total of 13 students attended the event from various colleges but were not registered for the event. Only 41 registered participants attended the event. The registered participants were explained the rules and regulations for filling the quiz Performa in the form of a google form. The quiz had 15 multiple choice questions. At 1:15 pm sharp the performa was shared over email of the registered candidates. It was also posted in the chat box. The link for the virtual quiz is as follows:

Participants were given 10 minutes to complete the quiz. All the participants were asked to switch on their cameras at the time of filling the form. At 1:25 pm sharp no further responses were entertained. The result was evaluated and a tie was found among 5 students. So they were administered a tie-braker of 5 multiple choice questions for 5 minutes. The link for the quiz was shared over the email of the shortlisted participants. After 5 minutes responses from all the shortlisted participants were obtained. The final results were evaluated.

The results were announced by the senior faculty members who attended the event. 


